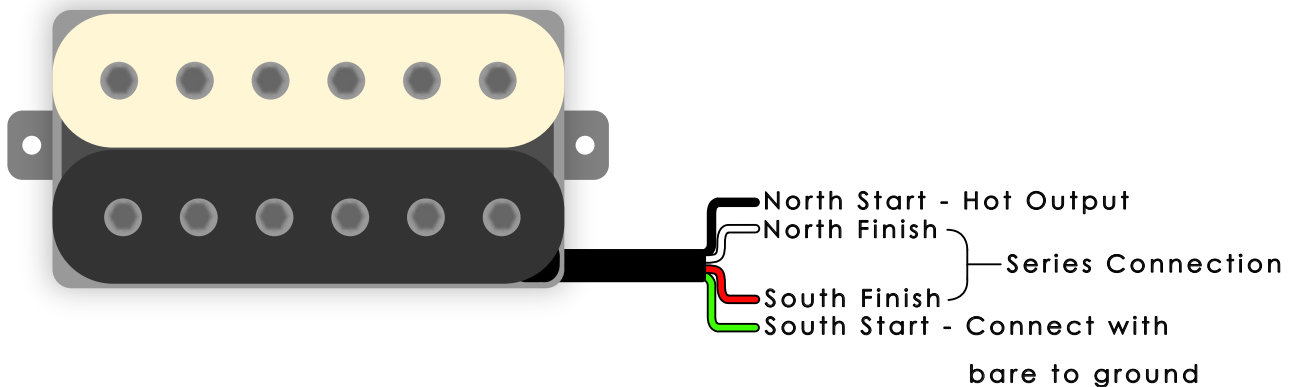
Below are the colour codes we use for all of our production models. Should you require any other kind of diagram, you will find all you need online as these colour codes are pretty much universal.

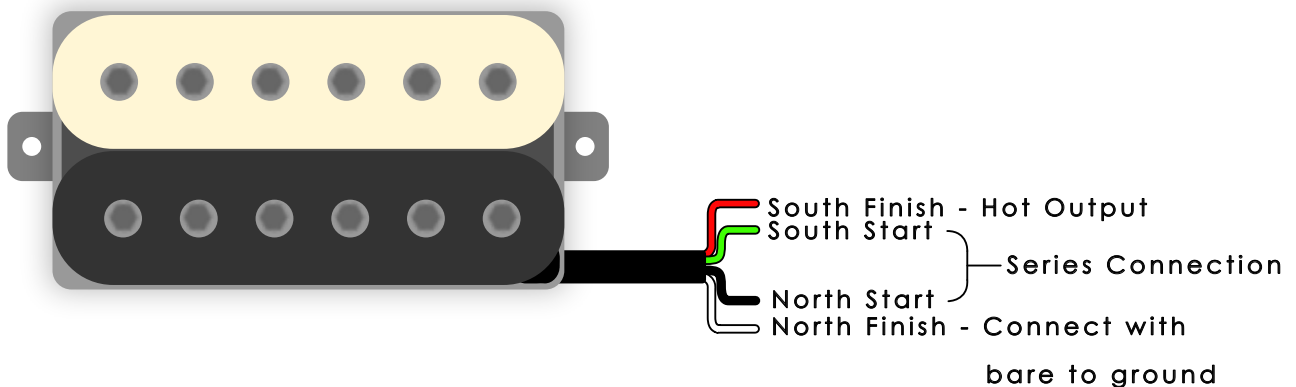

In the interest of keeping our colour codes universal, we have two configurations regarding them. The first is the **BRIDGE** which will operate as expected 99.9% of the time.

If you are combining one of our humbuckers with another brand and you're having phasing issues, please switch the **HOT** and **GROUND** wires.

PCB BASEPLATES AND QUICK CONNECT PLUGS

We recently started venturing into the world of PCB baseplates for a number of reasons. Mainly the ease of use for our customers, such as yourself.

The PCB plates not only ensure that the pickup is even quieter regarding noise, but it also ensures that we can use standardized mounting hardware such as M3 and M2.5 machine screws!

Below are the two most current colour codes we use for our three conductor and five conductor quick connect plugs.



Should you encounter any phasing issues when combined with a different pickup brand, please switch the **North Start** and **South Start** wires.
